New Door Prices - From Wednesday 1st April

Class Nights:

We took over Stockport Town Hall on Wed 2nd January 2019.

We have increased the price once by 50p BUT got the **car parking for FREE** which was a saving of 50p.

Room hire alone has gone **up by over 20%** since 2019 our increase to date was 6% some 2+ years ago. So we have absorbed most of this & other increases over the past 5 years.

Increasing our door price to £9.50pp (£1 extra) this is equivalent to a 19% increase in total, or **3.8% per year** (This includes the 50p increase from last time, but excludes FREE Parking).

However our door prices are still very similar to most (even cheaper than some) who are paying for Village Hall type venues, nothing like as grand.

Please take what a venue has to offer into consideration when looking at door prices: Free parking A Bar Huge Sprung Floor Good Sound & Lighting Equipment Size etc.

Freestyle Nights:

Our Freestyle Venue Hire has also gone up over 20% over the same 5 years, but we will only be increasing the Freestyles by £1pp (just 8%) or 1.6% per year

Other increases over the last 5 years for social type activities:

Cinema was $\pounds 7.12$ now $\pounds 10.95 = 54\%$ increase Theatre was $\pounds 27.10$ now $\pounds 49 = 81\%$ increase Pint of lager was $\pounds 3.67$ Now $\pounds 5.34 = 45\%$ increase Chocolate (No we haven't reduced the size of the venue like you see in a bar of chocolate!
